

SAMPLE Comprehensive Performance Examination

The Comprehensive Performance Examination consists of 40 multiple-choice test items similar to those shown as the SAMPLE Practice eQuiz. For example:

MULTIPLE CHOICE: You are on your honor to be truthful and honest. Read each item carefully. Select the one best alternative and click on that bubble.

A term is:

- A word shown in **bold**.
- The first word in a glossary/lexicon.
- A word or phrase with a precise meaning in context.
- A fancy way of saying something simple.

A 41st item allows the exam taker to demonstrate competence in the topic. Pencil-&-paper with pencils/pens are often needed for this test item. The product is assessed using the rubric below. Examples of 41st test items include:

- > For the lesson on TECHNICAL GRAPHIC COMMUNICATION: Sketch a three-dimensional five-pointed star.
- > For the lesson on JOB AID: Create a job aid, graphically or in writing, on how to parallel park a vehicle. (The answer should not be to buy a new car with automatic parallel parking.)
- > For the lesson on CONFINED SPACE ENTRY: Your situation is that you are the attendant stationed at the entry port to an underground confined space in which work is being performed. Your supervisor pulls up in a pickup and leaves the engine running. Exhaust vapors and fumes are flowing down into the confined space. Explain fully what you would do?
